

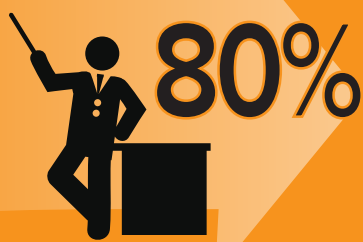

5 to 1 For every 5 active physicians
in Canada, there is 1 resident.

Over 70% of residents were born
in Canada, with the **other 30%**
coming from over 45 countries.

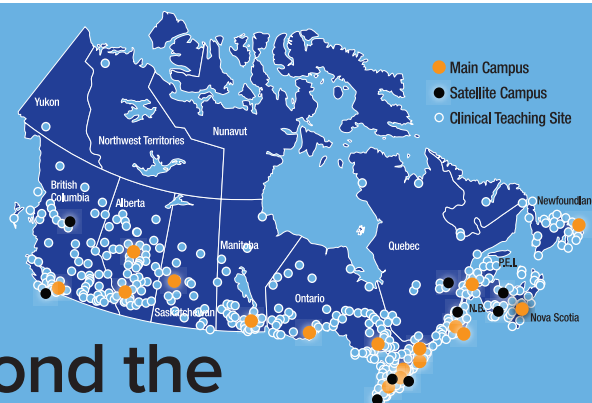
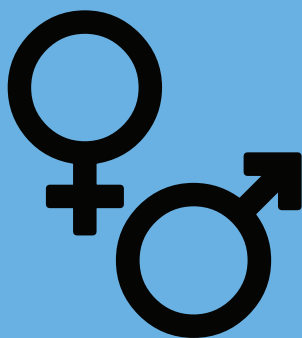


Fine Fellows
